Eva María Lantarón Caeiro has a degree in Physiotherapy from the University of Vigo (1998) and a PhD from the University of Málaga (2010). She is a specialist in Respiratory Physiotherapy by the Universidade da Coruña and in Manual Lymphatic Drainage by the Université Libre de Bruxelles. She made a teaching and research stay with an AECI grant at the Universidade Federal do Rio Grande do Norte (Natal-Brazil) and two stays at the Hospital Clínico Universitario de Valencia (Spain).



Professor at the Universidade de Vigo since April 1999, she obtained the position of Full Professor in 2003. She teaches Cardiorespiratory Physiotherapy and physiotherapy assessment, among others. He also teaches specialized continuing education courses. In relation to his research activity, he is a member of the Group FS1-Physiotherapy. His scientific production includes the co-authorship of more than 40 scientific articles (12 included in the JCR), two book chapters and 29 book/communication chapters and more than 100 communications in national and international congresses. He has supervised a PhD thesis and is currently supervising 2 theses and more than 50 end-of-degree projects.

Vice Chancellor of the Pontevedra Campus of the UVIGO, since June 2022, President of the National Conference of Deans of Faculties of Physiotherapy in the period December 2020 – December 2023. She developed in three periods the position of dean in the Faculty of Physiotherapy, where she was also deputy dean. At the University School of Physiotherapy she was deputy director and academic secretary. She coordinated the external academic practices of the physiotherapy degree for more than 18 years and the degree for three years.

She was vice-president of the Official College of Physiotherapists of Galicia (COFIGA) from 2000 to 2011, as well as councilor of the General Council of Colleges of Physiotherapists of Spain from its foundation until 2011. She directed the IV Postgraduate Course in thermal physiotherapy and balneotherapy as well as several continuing education courses and coordinated the Postgraduate Course of specialist in sports physiotherapy in four of its editions.
